

# University Graduates and Labour Market Questionnaire Structure (2006 and 2010 classes)

## Section A. Secondary studies

Questions regarding the secondary studies. Requested information: the type of the high school the graduate got his baccalaureate diploma from, the year in which the graduate got his/hers baccalaureate diploma.

## Section B. University studies

- Questions regarding the university study programs (bachelor, master, doctorate). Requested information: the institution where the graduate studied, the faculty and the study programs followed, the type of diploma obtained.

# Section C. Other forms of education and professional training

- Questions about other courses taken. Requested information: type of course, duration.

# Section D. The study program graduated in 2006/2010

- Detailed questions about the study program. Requested information: study program characteristics, the teaching-learning process, internships, scholarships, self-assessment of competences acquired at the end of the study program, study conditions assessment.

## Section E. Looking for a job

- Questions regarding the time spent looking for a job. Requested information: the period of time dedicated to looking for a job, the methods used to find a job, the number of employers contacted.

#### Section F. First job after graduation

Questions about the job the graduate had after graduating from the study program. Requested information: the number of jobs the graduate had, the type of contract, the number of working hours, the average income, the country/town in which the graduate found his/her first job, the level of education required for the first job, the extent to which the competences acquired during the study program have been used in the job.

# Section G. Current employment

- Questions regarding the graduate's current professional situation. Requested information: the number of jobs the graduate has, the sector and the field of activity of the company for which the graduate works, type of contract, position in the company, the number of working hours, the average income, the country/town in which the graduate works, the level of education required for the current job, the extent to which the competences acquired during the study program have been used in the current job, the level of satisfaction regarding current employment.

#### Section H. Retrospective assessment of the study program

- Questions regarding the utility of the reference study program followed by the graduate and the improvements it should go through.

#### Section I. Biographical data

- Questions regarding the date of birth, the gender, the ethnic group, the marital status and the place of residence.
